Construction Trades Scholarship for Students Pursuing an Associate Degree, Pre-Apprenticeship, Apprenticeship or Certificate Program

The <u>Graybar Construction Trades Scholarship</u> will be awarded to students across the United States who will enroll full time as undergraduate students in an accredited nonprofit two-year college or technical school program in the construction trades or enter an apprenticeship program. <u>Fifty</u> students will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship that is renewable for one additional year.

To be eligible, the applicant must:

- be a graduating high school senior or have recently earned a high school equivalency diploma (GED, HiSET, TASC)
- plan to enroll full time in a nonprofit community college, technical school, trade school, vocational school or apprenticeship program in the United States of America
- intend to complete an associate degree, pre-apprenticeship, apprenticeship, or certificate program leading to work in the construction trades
- have achieved a minimum grade point average (G.P.A.) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, 456 on the GED, or 60 on the HiSET (at least an 8 on each subtest) or equivalent scores on a state-sanctioned test
- · demonstrate financial need
