This etiquette also applies to <u>children</u> who are old enough to stand on their own. If a citizen is walking when the Anthem or Pledge of Allegiance begins one should STOP walking, stand at attention and place ones hand over ones heart until the Anthem or Pledge concludes. Males should remove any head coverings. Citizens should not eat or drink during the Anthem or Pledge. People should not mill around and talk during the Anthem or Pledge. Be a part of something bigger than yourself by demonstrating the proper respect.

***EXCEPTIONS: ALTHOUGH U.S. CODE 301 PROVIDES A GUIDE FOR PROPER ETIQUETTE. IT IS NOT CONSIDERED A LAW UNDER WHICH A PERSON MAY BE PROSECUTED IF HE/SHE CHOOSES NOT TO FOLLOW THE PROTOCOL. THE FIRST AMENDMENT OF THE U.S. CONSTITUTION PROTECTS THE RIGHTS OF THOSE WHO DO NOT FOLLOW THIS PROTOCOL FOR PERSONAL REASONS; I.E., IT IS AGAINST THE RELIGIOUS PRACTICE FOR JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES TO STAND DURING THE PLAYING OF ANY COUNTRY'S NATIONAL ANTHEM.
